CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Shiksha Kendra at DPS Vadodara is an endeavor to facilitate education to the underprivileged children dwelling in the neighboring areas of the school.

The Kendra functions with a vision to ensure primary education under National literacy mission for the children of 6 to 13 years. It also extends its help to the dropouts and the adolescent girl children so as to bring them back to the mainstream education. The curriculum of Shiksha Kendra includes the teaching of English, Mathematics, EVS & Gujarati. Apart from the teaching learning activities, the students are trained in various activities like origami, gift wrapping, greeting card making and quilt making. Shiksha Kendra provides vocational training to the girl students of 15-25 age group, in garment making and soft toy making. Shiksha Kendra conducts remedial teaching to the students of mainstream schooling.

The project which started in 2003 is currently running with 175 odd students. The school provides books, stationery, uniform, shoes and nutritious meals for free.

The students of Shiksha Kendra are a part and parcel of the sports and other co-curricular activities of the school. They are also exposed to the celebrations organized in the school.

The Kendra tries to bring these under privileged children to the mainstream of the society and ensures that they continue with education further at the secondary level in the same government aided schools.
